Explanation:

This Resolution seeks authorization to apply for the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) Waterway Assistance Grant in the amount of \$150,000. The grant requires a 50% match of \$150,000. The City has applied for a Broward Boating Improvement Program Grant (BBIP) which will serve as the match to the FIND grant (if awarded).

Funding in the amount of \$300,000 is contingent on both grants being awarded. In the event that the BBIP Grant of \$150,000 is not awarded to the City, the FIND Grant cannot be accepted. In the event that both grants are awarded, the Fiscal Year 2019 Operating Budget adopted on September 26, 2018 via Resolution R-2018-301 will be amended as indicated in Exhibit 1. It will also authorize the Department of Financial Services to establish accounts to properly monitor and track the revenues and expenditures.
