

IN RECOGNITION OF NATIONAL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT WEEK

APRIL 22-26, 2019

- WHEREAS:** APRIL 2019 MARKS THE 51ST ANNIVERSARY OF THE FAIR HOUSING ACT. THE WEEK OF APRIL 22-26, 2019, HAS BEEN DESIGNATED AS NATIONAL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT WEEK BY THE NATIONAL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATION TO CELEBRATE THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM, THE HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM (HOME), AND THE STATE HOUSING INITIATIVES PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (SHIP); AND
- WHEREAS:** OVER THE PAST FIVE YEARS, HOLLYWOOD HAS RECEIVED A TOTAL OF \$5,611,813.00 IN CDBG FUNDS, \$2,038,573.00 IN HOME FUNDS, AND \$3,161,601.00 IN SHIP FUNDS TO INVEST IN THE COMMUNITY; AND
- WHEREAS:** FEDERAL AND STATE PROGRAMS ARE A VITAL RESOURCE THAT ENABLE LOCAL COMMUNITIES TO PRESERVE AND CREATE DECENT, SAFE AND SANITARY AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND PROVIDE ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES FOR LOW AND MODERATE INCOME INDIVIDUALS; AND
- WHEREAS:** THESE FUNDS HAVE AIDED IN THE RELOCATION OF FAMILIES LIVING IN SUBSTANDARD CONDITIONS; CONSTRUCTION OF NEW, AFFORDABLE RENTAL UNITS FOR SENIORS; INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS IN LOW-TO-MODERATE INCOME AREAS; TEMPORARY RELOCATION ASSISTANCE; RENT ASSISTANCE; HOMEBUYER COUNSELING; HOUSING REHABILITATION AND HOUSING REPLACEMENT; AND INDUSTRY RECRUITMENT; AND
- WHEREAS:** SERVICES PROVIDED BY SUB-RECIPIENTS INCLUDE CRISIS INTERVENTION, SOCIAL SERVICE REFERRALS AND CASE MANAGEMENT, ASSISTANCE FOR VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, HOMELESS SUPPORT, EMPLOYMENT TRAINING AND PLACEMENT, CHILDCARE AND EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS, AND SENIOR PROGRAMS; AND
- WHEREAS:** CDBG, HOME AND SHIP PROGRAMS HAVE MADE CRUCIAL CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE VIABILITY OF THE HOUSING STOCK, INFRASTRUCTURE, PUBLIC SERVICES, AND ECONOMIC VITALITY OF THE COMMUNITY; NOW
- THEREFORE:** JOSH LEVY, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AND THE HOLLYWOOD CITY COMMISSION, HEREBY PROCLAIM APRIL 22-26, 2019, AS:
