Chapter 37 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby 19 amended to read as follows: 20 PART IV. BROWARD COUNTY PARKS SYSTEM FEE SCHEDULE 37.32. General. 21 22 The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), adopts and institutes the following amended fee schedule set forth below for the 23 24 Broward County Parks and Recreation Division ("Division"). All Pprograms or events Words in struck-through type are deletions from existing text. Words in Coding:

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sponsored or eo-sponsored cosponsored by the Division are exempt from the payment of fees set forth in this fee schedule. Programs sponsored by non-profit organizations (registered with the State of Florida or designated as an Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) corporation), other governmental entities, and private entities are required to pay the fees set forth in this fee schedule. All fees set forth in this fee schedule are subject to applicable State of Florida sales tax, unless such fees have been set to include sales tax or are exempt from sales tax. For fees set to include sales tax, the amount of sales tax shall be separately stated on the sales receipt. Any fees in the amount of \$2,500 or more must be paid by certified check payable to the Broward County Board of County Commissioners. Dishonored checks shall be subject to service fees and penalties as authorized under Section 35.3 of the Broward County Administrative Code.
