WHEREAS: NATIONAL GUN VIOLENCE AWARENESS DAY WAS ESTABLISHED TO HONOR AND REMEMBER

ALL VICTIMS AND SURVIVORS OF GUN VIOLENCE, AND TO DECLARE THAT WE AS A COUNTRY

MUST DO MORE TO REDUCE GUN VIOLENCE; AND

WHEREAS: EVERY DAY, 100 AMERICANS ARE KILLED BY GUN VIOLENCE AND ON AVERAGE THERE ARE

NEARLY 13,000 GUN HOMICIDES EVERY YEAR. AMERICANS ARE 25 TIMES MORE LIKELY TO

BE KILLED WITH GUNS THAN PEOPLE IN OTHER DEVELOPED COUNTRIES; AND

WHEREAS: SUPPORT FOR THE SECOND AMENDMENT RIGHTS OF LAW-ABIDING CITIZENS GOES HAND-

IN-HAND WITH KEEPING GUNS AWAY FROM DANGEROUS PEOPLE; AND

WHEREAS: HADIYA PENDLETON, A 15-YEAR-OLD TEENAGER WHO MARCHED IN PRESIDENT OBAMA'S

SECOND INAUGURAL PARADE WAS TRAGICALLY SHOT AND KILLED JUST WEEKS LATER IN

CHICAGO, AND SHOULD NOW BE CELEBRATING HER 22nd BIRTHDAY; AND

WHEREAS: TO HONOR HADIYA AND VICTIMS WHOSE LIVES WERE CUT SHORT, AS WELL AS SURVIVORS

INJURED BY SHOOTINGS, A NATIONAL COALITION OF ORGANIZATIONS DESIGNATED THE

FIRST FRIDAY IN JUNE AS NATIONAL GUN VIOLENCE AWARENESS DAY; AND

WHEREAS: THE IDEA WAS INSPIRED BY A GROUP OF HADIYA'S FRIENDS, WHO ASKED THEIR

CLASSMATES TO COMMEMORATE HER LIFE BY WEARING ORANGE. THEY CHOSE THIS COLOR BECAUSE HUNTERS WEAR ORANGE TO ANNOUNCE THEMSELVES TO OTHER HUNTERS WHEN IN THE WOODS. ORANGE IS ALSO A COLOR THAT SYMBOLIZES THE VALUE OF HUMAN LIFE:

WHEREAS: THE TRAGIC EVENTS AT MARIORY STONEMAN DOUGLAS HIGH SCHOOL, WHERE GUN

VIOLENCE RESULTED IN THE LOSS OF 17 STUDENTS AND FACULTY, AND THE WOUNDING OF

17 OTHERS, BRINGS GREATER ATTENTION TO THE NEED FOR AWARENESS; AND

WHEREAS: THE PUBLIC IS ENCOURAGED TO JOIN THIS CAMPAIGN BY PLEDGING TO WEAR ORANGE ON

THE FIRST FRIDAY IN JUNE 2019 TO HELP RAISE AWARENESS ABOUT GUN VIOLENCE IN

AMERICA. AND TO HONOR THE LIVES OF GUN VIOLENCE VICTIMS AND SURVIVORS: AND

WHEREAS: TO RENEW OUR COMMITMENT TO REDUCE GUN VIOLENCE, WE PLEDGE TO DO ALL WE CAN

TO KEEP FIREARMS OUT OF THE WRONG HANDS, AND ENCOURAGE RESPONSIBLE GUN
