Explanation:

This resolution seeks approval and authorization to execute an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with Broward County regarding the placement of the P25 equipment on the top of the Circ building or a tower in West Lake Park.

If the ILA is approved and executed, the City will be responsible for the following:

- City will pay 50% of the Independent Expert's costs and expenses
- City will pay capital costs in excess of the Expert's Capital Cost Estimate of West Lake Park (provided that if the actual costs come in lower than the County will credit that amount to other amounts owed by the City)
- City will pay support and maintenance costs in excess of the Expert's Base Annual Non-Rent Operations Cost Estimates annually

- City will pay rental costs of the Circ site in excess of \$4,809 (which is the current average rental cost to the County)
- City will pay for all costs and expenses for supplemental goods and/or services required for the Circ system to meet P25 Agreement standards
