AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, REPEALING SECTION 133.30 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED "DISCHARGING FIREARMS".

WHEREAS, Section 133.30 prohibits the discharge of a firearm within the territorial limits of the City, with certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, Section 790.33, Florida Statutes, expressly preempts the whole field of the regulation of firearms to the state and declares any existing ordinances which regulate firearms to be null and void; and

WHEREAS, due to the state law preemption, it is necessary to repeal Section 133.30 of the Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Ordinance.

<u>Section 2</u>: That Section 133.30 of the Hollywood Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed in its entirety.

<u>Section 3</u>: That it is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hollywood, Florida, and the provisions of this Ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.

<u>Section 4</u>: That if any word, phrase, clause, subsection or section of this Ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any remaining portions of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 5</u>: That all sections or parts of sections of the Code of Ordinances, all ordinances or parts of ordinances, and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 6</u>: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
