## **Proposed Legislation:**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE LEVYING AND COLLECTING OF NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENTS FOR THE COSTS OF ABATING NUISANCES OCCURRING ON REAL PROPERTY IN THE CITY THAT ARE PROHIBITED UNDER THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES; IMPOSING NUISANCE ABATEMENT ASSESSMENTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2019 AGAINST THE AFFECTED PROPERTIES WHERE THE CITY HAD WORK PERFORMED TO REMEDY THE NUISANCES; APPROVING THE ASSESSMENT AMOUNTS; APPROVING THE ASSESSMENT ROLL.

## **Explanation:**

This Resolution seeks to impose a nuisance abatement non-ad valorem assessment to recover costs associated with remedial work performed by the City related to abandon real or personal property.

The preliminary roll consisted of 127 properties with assessments totaling \$67,146. Following the preliminary roll, several property owners have paid off their assessments which reduced the outstanding assessments down to \$52,292.28. The Proposed FY 2020 Budget will remain at \$35,000 based on historical collection rates.

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
