Explanation:

This Resolution establishes a new Stormwater Rate and Fee Schedule for the Department of Public Utilities. The recommended adjustments are based on the July 2019 Rate Study Report provided by Lighthouse Utility Consulting. There has been no adjustment to the storm water rate since October 2009. Ordinance O-2019-______, also scheduled for the September 18, 2019 City Commission Agenda, authorizes the changes of schedule per Resolution.

This new schedule will begin October 1, 2019 and each consecutive year a price index adjustment will be enacted in correspondence with Florida Statutes. The rate adjustment is estimated to generate \$2,503,550 in revenues in Fiscal Year 2020 which will allow the department to continue efficient operations and make necessary enhancements, improvements, and upgrades to the system.
