A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT WITH FLSC, LLC TO PROVIDE A TEXTILE RECYCLING AND COLLECTION SERVICES PROGRAM.

## **Explanation:**

This Resolution seeks authorization to execute the first amendment to the agreement with FLSC, LLC to provide textile recycling and collection services. This amendment reduces the guaranteed franchise fees from \$100,000 per year to \$62,500. The guaranteed revenue will be adjusted annually on October 1<sup>st</sup> in accordance with the Consumer Price Index- All Urban Consumers' Miami-Fort Lauderdale.

The program was established via Ordinance No. O-2017-19 and all revenues collected are allocated to the Community Endowment Trust in the Special Revenue Fund (Fund 111). The fiscal impact of the proposed reduction is provided in a companion agenda item.
