**SUBJECT:** Agreement with Florida Department of Transportation for Construction/Installation of Improvements on A1A

---

I have reviewed the above referenced Agreement with the participating Department/Office(s), and the proposed general business terms and other significant provisions are as follows:

- 1) Department/Division involved – Development Services/City Engineer
- 2) Type of Agreement – Construction Agreement
- 3) Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) – n/a (the agreement with the contractor doing the construction/Installation will comply with procurement requirements)
- 4) Term of Contract:
  - a) initial – 548 days.
  - b) renewals (if any) –
  - c) who exercises option to renew –
- 5) Contract Amount – \$0.00 (the estimated cost of the project is \$10,000,000, but the CRA will pay those monies to the contractor doing the construction/installation).
- 6) Termination Rights – FDOT can terminate for convenience by giving 60 days' notice...
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements – City will indemnify FDOT.
- 8) Scope of Services – This agreement gives the City the right to construct/install pedestrian lighting, landscape, irrigation, hardscape, undergrounding of utilities, and a mast arm signal on A1A right-of-way.
- 9) Other Significant Provisions: None
