A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO DUVAL FORD, LLC FOR THE PURCHASE OF SEVEN VEHICLES FOR FIRE RESCUE AND BEACH SAFETY IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$218,456.00.

WHEREAS, on January 16, 2018, the City Commission approved R-2019-007, authorizing the Fire Rescue and Beach Safety Department to purchase 19 new vehicles to replace a portion of their aging fleet, as these vehicles are for maintenance and operational services; and

WHEREAS, the Department purchased one 2019 Chevrolet Tahoe 1500 and 11 2019 Ford Escapes, but was not able to purchase the seven 2019 Ford Explorers from Duval Ford, LLC, costing \$201,061.00, due to their unavailability at the time; and

WHEREAS, the Department desires to purchase seven 2020 Ford Explorers from Duval Ford, LLC, costing \$218,456.00; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Sheriffs Association via competitive bid, approved and authorized the award of Bid Number FSA19-VEL27.0 for Police Rated, Administrative, Utility vehicles, Trucks, and Vans for a term effective from October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, award was made to the lowest and most responsive bidder by specification, manufacturer and by zone; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.40 (C)(5) of the City's Purchasing Ordinance allows the Director to procure, without following formal procedures, all goods and services which are subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, provided that the goods and services are: (i) the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the state or the United States government, or (ii) the subject of a contract with another governmental entity or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, which contract is based strictly on competitive bids or competitive proposals and not on any preference; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief and the Director of Procurement and Contract Compliance recommend that the City Commission approve the issuance of a purchase order to Duval Ford, LLC for seven vehicles for Fire Rescue and Beach Safety Command

Staff and Fire Inspector to replace a portion of the aging fleet for maintenance and operational services for an estimated amount of \$218,456.00; and

WHEREAS, funding for the attached agreement has been appropriated and exists in account number 557.219901.51900.564520.000234.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the issuance, by the appropriate City officials, of a purchase order to Duval Ford, LLC totaling \$218,456.00, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
