A RESOLUTION OF THE HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY ("CRA"), AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CRA OFFICIALS TO ISSUE AN AUTHORIZATION TO PROCEED WITH BERMELLO AJAMIL & PARTNERS TO PROVIDE CONSULTING SERVICES FOR HOLLYWOOD BOULEVARD AND TYLER STREET IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE DOWNTOWN DISTRICT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$167,730.36.

WHEREAS, the Hollywood Downtown Plan was revised to improve the character and attract redevelopment to the Hollywood Boulevard corridor; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2017, pursuant to Resolution 2017-21, the Community Redevelopment Agency "(CRA") Board authorized appropriate CRA officials to negotiate and execute contracts with five firms that were selected to provide architectural design services for the CRA; and

WHEREAS, CRA staff requested a proposal for Hollywood Boulevard and Tyler Street Streetscape Analysis ("Project") from one of the five consultants, Bermello Ajamil & Partners ("BA"); and

WHEREAS, BA provided a proposal in the amount of \$167,730.36 to perform services associated with the Project master plan, providing evaluation and assessment of the existing data, assessment of the existing parking inventory, analysis of the existing drainage system, preliminary concept development, preliminary parking strategies, drainage analysis, cost estimate, and final concept plans and recommendations, including 3D photorealistic renderings; and

WHEREAS, funding for this Project is available in account number 166.668605.55200.531170.000000.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY:
