A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE BROWARD COUNTY MARINE ADVISORY COMMITTEE, TO RECEIVE THE FY 2020-2021 ENHANCED MARINE LAW ENFORCEMENT AND **EDUCATION** GRANT: AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ACCEPT. IF AWARDED, THE GRANT APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$63,368.00; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ALL APPLICABLE GRANT DOCUMENTS AND AGREEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Police Department submitted an application to the Broward County Marine Advisory Committee for the FY 2020-2021 Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement and Education Grant; and

WHEREAS, FY 2020-2021 Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement and Education Grant funds will be approximately \$63,368.00; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Broward County Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant program is to improve boating safety in Broward County by providing funds for the enhancement of Marine Law Enforcement and education; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to promote and enhance the safe and pleasurable use of the navigable waterways within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to protect and preserve the natural and man-made marine resources available throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that by the submission of the grant proposal, the City will abide by the terms and conditions set forth by the Broward County Marine Advisory Committee for use of the grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police recommends that the City Commission authorize the appropriate City officials to accept, if awarded, the FY 2020-2021 Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement and Education Grant funds from the Broward County Marine Advisory Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>: That it ratifies the submission of the application for the FY 2020-2021 Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement and Education Grant funds to the Broward County Marine Advisory Committee.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to accept the grant, if awarded, provided that the City Manager shall have the discretion to refuse the grant in those circumstances where he determines it is in the best interest of the City to do so, in which case he shall advise the City Commission of his intention to refuse the grant.

<u>Section 4</u>: That it approves and authorizes the appropriate City officials to execute all grant documents and agreements upon receiving the grant funds, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 5</u>: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
