- 1) Department/Division involved Dept. of Public Utilities
- 2) Type of Agreement Purchase Orders
- Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) **Piggyback. City of Fort Lauderdale Bid No. 473011907.** Section 38.40(C)(5) of the City's Purchasing Ordinance allows the Director to procure, without following formal procedures, all goods and services which are subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, provided however, the goods and services are: (i) the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the state or the United States government, or (ii) the subject of a contract with another governmental entity or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, which contract is based strictly on competitive bids or competitive proposals and not on any preference.
- 4) Term of Contract:
 - a) initial one year
 - b) renewals (if any) yes, four additional one year terms.
 - c) who exercises option to renew mutual
- 5) Contract Amount In an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00.
- 6) Termination Rights yes, with or without cause.
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements Yes.
- 8) Scope of Services GPE will provide construction services for the City's stormwater facilities that includes rehabilitation, repair and replacement work.

- 9) Other Significant Provisions- City of Fort Lauderdale's Contract with Southeastern Engineering provides for warranties and liquidated damages.
