A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH SUNSHINE STATE MEDIA, INC. TO MAINTAIN THE EXISTING BUS BENCH AND BUS SHELTER PROGRAM, FOR A FIVE YEAR PERIOD COMMENCING JUNE 3, 2019.

WHEREAS, Section 337.408(1), Florida Statutes, provides that a municipality may authorize the installation, without public bid, of benches and transit shelters together with advertising displayed thereon within the right-of-way limits of such roads; and

WHEREAS, the City operates a bus bench and bus shelter program providing facilities for 546 bus stop locations throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2009, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2009-133, which approved the Bus Bench Agreement with Sunshine Media, Inc. ("Contractor") to provide bus benches and bus shelters for use by public transportation patrons within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City's existing agreement with the Contractor expired on June 3, 2019, and the Department of Development Services, Engineering, Transportation & Mobility Division has determined that it is beneficial for the City to continue to allow the Contractor to oversee the maintenance and operation of the existing bus benches and shelters within the City; and

WHEREAS, the parties have negotiated a new agreement that includes a revenue sharing provision as more specifically set forth in Schedule "A" of the attached agreement; and

WHEREAS, the term of the agreement is for a period of five years commencing on June 3, 2019, with an option to renew for one additional five year term under the same terms and conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:
