- 1) Department/Division involved Police
- 2) Type of Agreement –Agreement for the purpose of installing, operating and maintaining the City's equipment for its CCTV project
- 3) Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) N/A
- 4) Term of Contract:
  a) initial 10 years
  b) renewals (if any) 10 year automatic renewal
  c) who exercises option to renew either party may exercise right not to renew
- 5) Contract Amount N/A
- Termination Rights City may terminate upon 30 days notice; Walgreen Co. may terminate upon 12 months notice
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements City shall indemnify and hold harmless Walgreen Co. for damage to the relating to the occupancy or use of the property
- Scope of Services City shall have the right tot use a portion of Walgreen Co.'s property, located at 5999 Pembroke Road, to install ALPR Equipment
- 9) Other Significant Provisions:
