  - a) initial One year, expired on March 4, 2020.
  - b) renewals (if any) Yes, three additional one year terms. Pursuant to Section 38.48(B) of the Purchasing Code, the City Manager due to the COVID-19 state of events, extended this agreement for operational purposes for a period of 90 days bringing the existing agreement to June 4, 2020. This item will be the first renewal, and the term will be retroactive to March 5, 2020 and will expire on March 4, 2021.
  - c) who exercises option to renew- Mutual
- 5) Contract Amount In the estimated annual amount of \$885,360.00. This agreement is jointly funded by the CRA (2/3s) and the City (1/3).
- 6) Termination Rights with or without cause.

- 8) Scope of Services Circuit Transit, Inc. will continue to provide circulator services to and from Downtown Hollywood, Hollywood Beach, and the City's parking garages.
