Todd is a fifteen (15) year resident of the Hollywood Lakes Neighborhood, and is a longtime area business owner and civil rights activist. He is also both a residential and commercial property owner in Hollywood, and is the building manager of the Boulevard Landmark Building. Todd is also an MBA graduate of Strayer University. In 2014 he and his husband sued for the right to marry in Florida, and were subsequently one of the first two couples in the State (the first from Broward) to be married. Together they are raising their son, Blake, who is a student at Beachside Montessori Village. Besides involvement with Equality Florida, NCLR and the NGL Task Force at the State and National level, this year Todd joined other Hollywood residents and business owners to found the Hollywood LGBTQ+ Council, whose mission is "to elevate the voices, perspectives, and presence of LGBTQ+ residents and entrepreneurs in shaping the vision for a vibrant and inclusive city."

Todd was appointed to the City of Hollywood's Sustainability Advisory Committee in 2019, and has also joined the Board of the Chamber of Commerce (ex-Officio), and the DHBA.
