A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, SETTING THE PROPOSED ("NOT TO EXCEED") MILLAGE RATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 200.065 (2)(b), FLORIDA STATUTES, AND SETTING THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE AT WHICH A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSED ("NOT TO EXCEED") MILLAGE RATE AND TENTATIVE BUDGET.

WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, commonly known as the "Truth in Millage" Bill or the "TRIM" Bill, provides that each taxing authority shall advise the Property Appraiser of its proposed millage rate, of its current rolled back rate and of the date, time, and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and tentative budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and is incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That the proposed ("not to exceed") tax millage rate of the City of Hollywood for Fiscal Year 2021 shall be:

Operating Millage:	7.4665
Voted 2005 Debt Service Millage:	0.2200
Voted 2019 Debt Service Millage:	0.2361

<u>Total Proposed ("Not To Exceed") Millage Rate:</u>	7.9226

Section 3: That the rolled-back rate for FY 2021 is X.XXX mills. As defined in Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the "rolled-back rate" is that certain millage rate which, exclusive of: new construction, additions to structures, deletions, increases in the value of improvements that have undergone a substantial rehabilitation which increased the assessed value of such improvements by at least 100 percent, property added due to geographic boundary changes, total taxable value of tangible personal property within the jurisdiction in excess of 115 percent of the previous year's total taxable value, and any dedicated increment value, will provide the same ad valorem tax revenue as was levied during the prior year less the amount, if any, paid or applied as a consequence of an obligation measured by the dedicated increment value.

RESOLUTION SETTING THE PROPOSED ("NOT-TO-EXCEED") MILLAGE RATE AND SETTING THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE AND TENTATIVE BUDGET.

Section 4: That the date, time and place of the public hearing to consider the above proposed ("not to exceed") millage rate and tentative budget shall be as follows:

Section 5: That City Administration is directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to the Office of the Broward County Property Appraiser.
