A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE RULES OF PROCEDURE FOR THE GOVERNING OF CITY COMMISSION MEETINGS.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of City Charter §2.04(d), the City Commission may determine its own rules of procedure; and

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2014, the City Commission passed Resolution No. R-2014-129, and on July 3, 2018, the City Commission passed Resolution No. R-2018-196, which is the latest version of its Rules of Procedure; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to include a limitation on the length of Proclamations, Awards and Presentations made during City Commission meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the forgoing “WHEREAS” clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That the Rules of Procedure for the governing of City Commission Meetings are hereby amended to read as follows:

Proclamations, Awards and Presentations.

Proclamations, awards and presentations will be made during the regular City Commission meetings at a time certain designated by the City Manager. Unless the Chair permits otherwise following request of the City Manager, each proclamation, award and presentation shall be limited to no more than 15 minutes.

Section 3: All other provisions of the July 3, 2018 Rules of Procedure not revised herein shall remain in full force and effect.

Words and figures underlined are additions to existing text, and words and figures struck-through are deletions from existing text.
