SUBJECT: Proposed First Amendment to the Agreement with Hope South

Florida, Inc. to provide eviction prevention assistance through SHIP

funding for rent and utilities.

I have reviewed the above referenced Agreement with the participating Department/Office(s), and the proposed general business terms and other significant provisions are as follows:

- 1) Department/Division involved Department of Development Services/Community Development Division
- 2) Type of Agreement First Amendment to the Agreement, specifically amending Exhibit "A" to revise funding threshold for eligible beneficiary and increase the funding time frame from three months to six months.
- 3) Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) Original approval based upon, **Best Interest** pursuant to Section 38.40(C)(8) which requires a 5/7ths vote.
- 4) Term of Contract:
  - a) initial commences on June 7, 2020 and expires on June 7, 2021.
  - b) renewals (if any) no, however, contract term may be extended in accordance with agreement.
  - c) who exercises option to renew City.
- 5) Contract Amount In an amount not to exceed \$510,000.00. This first amendment does not change the total contract price, however, Exhibit "A" is being replaced with a new Exhibit "A" to revise the eligible beneficiary threshold amount from \$5,000.00 to \$10,000.00.
- 6) Termination Rights with or without cause.
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements Yes, as to indemnity.
- 8) Scope of Services Hope South Florida, Inc. shall provide rental and utility assistance to those eligible recipients due to COVID-19 utilizing SHIP funds.
- 9) Other Significant Provisions: n/a
