A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. R-2020-112 AND AMENDING THE ONE YEAR ACTION PLAN FOR FEDERAL PROGRAM FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 TO ALLOCATE \$739,276.00 OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT COVID-19 FUNDS; AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 OPERATING BUDGET.

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2020, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2020-112 that amended the 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 to allocate \$739,276.00 Of Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") COVID-19 funds and re-allocated \$1,050,123.21 of Home Investment Partnerships Act ("HOME") funds; and

WHEREAS, after Resolution No. R-2020-112 was passed and adopted by the City Commission, it was discovered by the Community Development Division that the Sun Sentinel did not publish the required Public Hearing Advertisement in the newspaper; and

WHEREAS, due to the error regarding the public hearing advertisement, a new public hearing is required for the allocation of the CDBG funds for federal Fiscal Year 2019 through 2020; and

WHEREAS, the amendment of CDBG funds for federal Program Years 2015 through 2019 will be brought back to the City Commission at a later date, as such amendment requires a different notice requirement; and

WHEREAS, proper notice has been provided to the citizens of Hollywood to provide the opportunity for citizens to comment in accordance with COVID-19 waiver requirements set forth in 24 CFR 91.105(c)(2) and (k) and 24 CFR 91.401; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority provided under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security ("CARES") Act, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development allocated supplemental CDBG funding with specific waivers to respond to the COVID-19 health emergency ("CDBG-CV"); and

WHEREAS, the City has received an appropriation of CDBG-CV funding that is available to be allocated for program use; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends allocating CDBG-CV funds as follows:

Job Referral/Placement	\$ 30,000.00
Food Pantry	\$ 40,000.00
General Emergency Asst.	\$46,420.80
Micro-Enterprise Asst.	\$475,000.00
General Administration	\$147,855.20

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

\$739,276.00.

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>: That Resolution No. R-2020-112 is repealed in its entirety.

Section 3: That it authorizes and approves amending the One Year Action Plan for federal Program Year 2019 through 2020, as set forth in the attached Exhibit "1".

<u>Section 4</u>: That these Amendments, Adjustments and Transfers of funding to the 2020 Operating Budget for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2019 and set forth in detail in the attached Exhibit "1" are adopted and authorized as Amendments to the Operating Budget of the Special Revenue Fund of the City of Hollywood, Florida, for Fiscal Year 2020.

<u>Section 5</u>: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
