A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY AUTHORIZING OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ISSUE A BLANKET PURCHASE ORDER WITH ALLIED UNIVERSAL CORPORATION TO RENEW THE AGREEMENT FOR DELIVERY OF SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE IN AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$250,000.00.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Utilities requires weekly deliveries of Sodium Hypochlorite 12% for Water Treatment Plant Operations; and

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2017, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution Number R-2017-346, which authorized the issuance of a Blanket Purchase Order with Allied Universal Corporation based upon the City of Fort Lauderdale's Cooperative Bid No. 12006-372 in accordance with Section 38.46 of the City's Purchasing Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, on August 28, 2019, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution Number R-2019-234, which renewed Blanket Purchase Order B003074 for the first one year renewal period; and

WHEREAS, the first renewal period expires on October 2, 2020, and the agreement provides for one additional one year renewal period; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Utilities desires to renew the agreement for the final one year period in order to receive the delivery of sodium hypochlorite for the Water Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Utilities and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve the issuance of a blanket purchase order to renew the agreement with Allied Universal Corporation for the purchase of Sodium Hypochlorite in an estimated annual amount of \$250,000.00; and

WHEREAS, award is subject to the City's receipt and approval of all insurance certificates and endorsements required by the City's Risk Manager; and

WHEREAS, funding for this service will be budgeted in subsequent fiscal years' operating budgets subject to approval and adoption by the City Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>: That it approves and authorizes the issuance, by the appropriate City officials, of the attached blanket purchase order with Allied Universal Corporation, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 3</u>: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
