A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD LEGISLATIVE AGENDA FOR THE UPCOMING STATE 2021 LEGISLATIVE SESSION.

WHEREAS, each year, the City of Hollywood develops a legislative agenda in order to direct staff and lobbyists to influence and monitor bills that may have a direct or indirect impact upon the City; and

WHEREAS, this allows the City to participate in the legislative process that will benefit all residents of Hollywood; and

WHEREAS, the development of a legislative agenda provides the City an opportunity to support or oppose various issues being raised during the legislative session; and

WHEREAS, the attached Exhibit "A" identifies the major priorities of the legislative agenda proposed for the City in 2021; and

WHEREAS, top state priorities include amendment of regulations for vacation rental properties to allow municipalities to regulate frequency and duration; funding for beach renourishment, sand-by pass, ocean outfall closure, and resiliency projects; and the preservation of local mitigation provision in the Seminole Compact.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.
