A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY APPROVING OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ISSUE A BLANKET PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH MBR CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,501,545.00 BASED UPON BROWARD COUNTY'S REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFQ NO. PNC2120194B1) IN ACCORDANCE 38.41(C)(5) WITH SECTION OF THE CITY'S PROCUREMENT CODE (PIGGYBACK).

WHEREAS, the City's Fiscal Year 2020- FY2021 Sidewalk Corridors Project includes proposed new sidewalk projects along various streets within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2020-21 Sidewalk Corridors Project is within the City's FY 2020-21 Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, in order to implement the Fiscal Years 2020-21 Sidewalk Corridors Project, the Department of Development Services' Engineering, Transportation and Mobility Division desires to retain a company to perform the required sidewalk construction services; and

WHEREAS, the desired services were competitively bid by Broward County pursuant to RFQ No. PNC2120194B1 on November 10, 2020, and the current term of the contract is from November 10, 2020 through November 20, 2022, with an option to renew the contract for an additional one-year period; and

WHEREAS, Broward County awarded the bid to MBR Construction, Inc. ("MBR"), and MBR has agreed to extend to the City the same pricing under the terms and conditions set forth in Broward County's RFQ and contract; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.41(C)(5) of the City's Procurement Code allows the Chief Procurement Officer to procure, without formal solicitation procedures, all goods, supplies, materials, equipment, and services that are the subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof ("piggyback"), provided that the goods, supplies, materials, equipment, or services are the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the entities listed above and is based strictly on competitive bids, quotations, or competitive proposals and not on any preference and such utilization of other governmental entities contracts shall be permitted only during the term of the other governmental entity's contract; and WHEREAS, the project's estimated cost will not exceed \$2,501,545.00; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Development Services, the City Engineer and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve the issuance of a Blanket Purchase Agreement to MBR Construction, Inc. based upon Broward County's RFQ PNC 2118157B1 to provide sidewalk construction services for the sidewalk corridors projects pursuant to the Fiscal Year 2020-21 Sidewalk Corridors; and

WHEREAS, \$440,000.00.00 in funding is available in account number 336.149901.54100.563010.001279.000.000; and

WHEREAS, \$2,061,545.00 in funding is available in account number 111.160502.51900.583440.001247.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>: That it approves and authorizes the issuance, by the appropriate City officials, of the attached Blanket Purchase Agreement with MBR Construction, Inc., together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 3</u>: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
