The City of Hollywood has been facing an increasing issue with derelict vessels. Increased enforcement of "at-risk" vessel violations has led to improvements. Several derelict vessels have been removed by their respective owners or with local grant funding. However, some vessels still remain. At the time of this application, I have identified 3 derelict vessels eligible for removal within the City of Hollywood that require removal at a total cost of \$113,206.00. At the present time, 4 derelict vessels are identified in the waters of Hollywood. One is in the process of removal by its owner after a misdemeanor case. Funding from this project would remove 75% of identified derelict vessels that meet funding guidelines at the time of this application. Thank you for your consideration
