3. P-2021-53 City Manager's Recommended Budget Presentation.

Dr. Wazir Ishmael, City Manager, provided an overview of the proposed balanced budget. He reviewed initiatives that will be taken in the upcoming fiscal year.

4. R-2021-243

A Resolution Of The City Commission Of The City Of Hollywood, Florida, Fixing The Amount And Rate Of Taxation For The Fiscal Year Commencing October 1, 2021, And Making The Tax Levy For The Year 2021.

Mayor Levy read the title of the resolution "A Resolution Of The City Commission Of The City Of Hollywood, Florida, Fixing The Amount And Rate Of Taxation For The Fiscal Year Commencing October 1, 2021 and Making The Tax Levy For The Year 2021."

Mayor Levy stated "The proposed millage rate set by the City Commission of the City of Hollywood on September 13, 2021 is 7.4810 mills, which is estimated to generate general fund net revenues of one hundred thirty-four million, seven hundred and twenty-nine thousand, four hundred and one dollars (\$134,729,401.00). This millage rate represents a 4.39% increase over the rolled-back rate of 7.1663 mills."

The Mayor announced the resolution was advertised in conformance with Florida Statutes and City Codes. The public hearing was opened; there being no one present who wished to speak, the public hearing was declared closed.

Discussion ensued among staff and members of the Commission.

<u>ACTION:</u> Motion was made by Commissioner Callari, which was seconded by Vice Mayor Sherwood, to adopt the Resolution. On a voice vote the motion passed 5-2. Commissioner Gruber and Mayor Levy were opposed.
