A Resolution Of The City Commission Of The City Of Hollywood, Florida, Establishing The Cost For Recovery Fee For Fire Watch Details In Accordance With Section 93.026(E) Of The Code Of Ordinances.

Staff Recommends: Approval of the attached Resolution.

**Explanation:**

On February 17, 2016, the City Commission passed and adopted Ordinance No. PO-2016-01 which created Section 94.026 to establish guidelines for Fire Watch Details.

Section 94.026(E) expressly states that all costs for recovery of a Fire Watch shall be established by Resolution of the City Commission.

Five (5) local Fire Rescue Departments were surveyed as to the rate they charged for a Fire Watch detail. The rate of \$45.00 is comparable to the survey results and the prior rate that the City of Hollywood was charging.
