## **Explanation:**

On June 7, 2023, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2023-149, approving an agreement with the City and the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity for \$760,335.00 to provide laptops and network wiring to low- and moderate-income community centers and homeless services. The Taskforce Fore Ending Homelessness possesses the requisite skills, staffing infrastructure and experience to locate, identify, and assess the assistance needs for homeless individuals and families and refer them to appropriate resources. The City desires to retain the services of The Taskforce Fore Ending Homelessness in the amount of \$200,000.00 pursuant to Section 38.41(C)(9) of the Procurement Code (Best Interest).
