Staff Recommends: Approval of the attached Resolution.

Explanation:

The City is responsible for ensuring the efficient and cost-effective functioning of the wastewater collection system including 85 lift stations and over 280 miles of sewer gravity and force mains. The Department of Public Utilities ("Department") has a long-standing program to reduce the inflow and infiltration ("I/I") of ground and stormwater to the wastewater collection system, which program includes the repair of manholes, and other wastewater collection system components.

On May 3, 2023, pursuant to Resolution No. R-2023-123, the City Commission authorized the execution of a unit price contract with Envirowaste Services Group, Inc. ("Envirowaste") in an amount not to exceed \$1,057,085.00 for I/I Program - Manhole Repairs. The contract with Envirowaste was for an initial term of one year, with two optional one-year renewal terms under the same terms and conditions.
