A Resolution Of The Hollywood, Florida, Community Redevelopment Agency, Authorizing The Appropriate CRA Officials To Execute The Attached First Amendment To The Interlocal Agreement With The City Of Hollywood For Community Bus And Transit Services.

Explanation:

On April 20, 2016, the City of Hollywood City Commission approved R-2016-102, which authorized the execution of an Interlocal Agreement with Broward County (the "County") for financial assistance for several community bus service routes (Trolley).

On April 20, 2016, the City of Hollywood, Florida Community Redevelopment Agency approved R-CRA-2016-103, which authorized the execution of an Interlocal Agreement with City of Hollywood for operation of several community bus service routes (Trolley) and allows the funding from the Broward County Transit Interlocal Agreement for financial assistance.

The parties desire to enter into a First Amendment modifying the Interlocal Agreement to reduce the service hours and funding for existing routes and allow for the modification and/or termination of financial assistance for underperforming community bus service routes.
