Explanation:

The State Housing Initiatives Partnership (“SHIP Act”), 420.907-420.9079 Florida Statutes, and Rule 67-37, Florida Administrative Code, requires local governments to develop a one- to three-year Local Housing Assistance Plan outlining how the allocated funds will be used.

In addition, local governments must annually report on the new and existing housing benefiting from awards made pursuant to the funding.

The Florida Housing Finance Corporation requests that all local governments present the SHIP-AR at a public meeting of the local Governing Body.

The Department of Development Services has prepared a SHIP-AR and is presenting it to the City Commission for approval prior to transmitting the document to the Florida Housing Finance Corporation.
