Explanation:

On March 3, 2021 the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2021-058, authorizing appropriate officials to submit a pre-application grant packet for Community Development Block Grant-Coronavirus Funds from the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity ("DEO") in the amount of \$760,335.00.

On June 16, 2021, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution R-2021-154, approving and authorizing the appropriate officials to submit a final application grant packet for Community Development Block Grant-Coronavirus Funds from the DEO in the amount of \$760,335.00.
