A Resolution Of The City Commission Of The City Of Hollywood, Florida, Appointing Nine Members To The Parks, Recreation And Cultural Arts Advisory Board.

Explanation:

The City of Hollywood, Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts Advisory Board ("Board") was established by the City Commission to promote parks, recreation, cultural arts, special events and golf operations within the City.

Resolution R-2022-158 was amended to increase the Youth membership from two to three on the Board.

The Board now consists of nine adult members and three youth members whose interests and focus are on the recreational, athletic or cultural arts aspects of the Department.
