In accordance with the City's Purchasing Ordinance, Section 38.41(C) (10), purchases of insurance through the City's "Agent of Record" are exempt from the competitive bid and competitive proposal requirements. Utilizing RFP 4606-19-AP and Resolution R-2019-116, the City designated Aon Risk Services, Inc. of Florida as its broker of record.
