The Police Department is requesting authorization to expend Federal (Treasury) Law Enforcement Forfeiture Funds in the amount of \$285,000.00 for costs associated with the acquisition of law enforcement equipment for use by law enforcement personnel that supports law enforcement activities. The funds will be used to purchase new and replacement firearms.
