A Resolution Of The City Commission Of The City Of Hollywood, Florida, Amending Resolution No. R-2018-146 And Authorizing The Appropriate City Officials To Accept The Areawide Council On Aging Of Broward County, Inc. Grant, In The Amount Of \$228,000.00; Approving And Authorizing The Appropriate City Officials To Execute The Local Service Programs Contract, The Master Contract And Memorandum Of Understanding With The Areawide Council On Aging Of Broward County, Inc. To Provide Enhanced Senior Citizen Recreation Programs; And Further Authorizing The Appropriate City Officials To Execute All Applicable Grant Documents And Agreements.

Explanation:

In its Fiscal Year 2001 budget process, the State of Florida, through the Department of Elder Affairs, appropriated funding in the amount of \$228,000.00 to the City of Hollywood.

This funding was approved by the State of Florida to be awarded to the City of Hollywood on a reoccurring annual basis, contingent upon the availability of such funds at State level.

On May 16, 2018 (R-2018-146) the City Commission approved and authorized execution of the Local Service Programs Master Contract and Memorandum of Understanding for Fiscal Year 2018/2019.

This Resolution seeks to amend Resolution No. R-2018-146 with the correct contracts attached in error with for execution for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 for the acceptance and appropriation of funding for the Areawide Council on Aging of Broward County, Inc. Elder Grant.
