An Ordinance Of The City Of Hollywood, Florida, Amending Chapter 98 Of The Code Of Ordinances Prohibiting Live Aboard Vessels In Certain Areas And Creating Restrictions On The Use Of Public Property.

Staff Recommends: Approval of the attached Ordinance.

Explanation:

Over the past several years the City has experienced an increase in the number of vessels anchoring in North and South Lake. Pursuant to state statute the City is preempted from regulating the anchoring of vessels outside the marked boundaries of a mooring field, except for live aboards. Vessel owners or operators tie up vessels to City property for an extended period of time and the City wishes to prohibit such behavior.

Approval of this ordinance will not fiscally impact the City.
