

RESOLUTION NO. R-2024-252

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE RANKING OF VARIOUS FIRMS FOR OWNER-OCCUPIED HOUSING REHABILITATION, RESIDENTIAL ROOFING SERVICES AND IMPACT WINDOW AND DOOR SERVICES; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE BLANKET PURCHASE AGREEMENTS WITH EACH OF THE HIGHEST RANKED FIRMS IN A COMBINED AMOUNT OF UP TO \$3,000,000.00 ANNUALLY.

WHEREAS, the Division of Community Development ("Division") desires to create a qualified pool of State of Florida General Contractors to provide construction services in conjunction with the City's Owner-Occupied Housing Rehabilitation Program (Category 1); and

WHEREAS, the Division desires to expand the list of firms currently providing emergency residential roofing services (Category 2), which provide emergency repairs to damaged roofs to prevent further deterioration; and

WHEREAS, the Division desires to expand the list of firms currently providing the installation of hurricane impact windows and doors (Category 3), which will aid in energy reduction and infiltration of outside elements of owner-occupied dwellings; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.43 of the Procurement Code states that when the estimated annual cost of goods, supplies, materials, equipment, or services exceeds \$50,000, a formal solicitation process shall be completed that may result in a written contract(s) and/or purchase order(s) after due public notice inviting bids or proposals; and

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2024, Request for Qualifications Number RFQ-162-24-SK ("RFQ") was electronically advertised on OpenGov.com to solicit the desired contractors for Owner-Occupied Housing Rehabilitation, Residential Roofing, and Impact Windows and Doors, in accordance with Section 38.43(A) of the Procurement Code; and

WHEREAS, the RFQ submittal deadline was February 14, 2024, and resulted in Statement of Qualifications ("SOQs") from 38 firms as follows:

WHEREAS, the Selection Committee met to evaluate and rank the SOQs for Categories 1, 2, and 3 based upon the approved Evaluation Criteria established in the RFQ; and

WHEREAS, the Selection Committee evaluated all SOQs, and removed three firms (A-1 Mechanical Services, Inc., Resipro LLC, and Stacy Bomar Construction LLC) from the qualifications process for reasons that include improper licensures, previous litigation, and past non-compliance with the City's Owner-Occupied Housing Rehabilitation Program; and

WHEREAS, the scores were compiled to arrive at the following rankings for each category, with the highest score being the highest ranked:

WHEREAS, the Division recommends that the City Commission authorize the execution of a Blanket Purchase Agreement for a term of three years with each of the highest ranked firms under Category 1; and

WHEREAS, the Division recommends that the City Commission authorize the execution of a Blanket Purchase Agreement with each of the highest ranked firms under Category 2 and 3 and to add these firms under the current ranking for Residential Roofing, Impact Windows and Doors, which expires on October 31, 2026, as approved under Resolution No. R-2023-318; and

WHEREAS, funding for the Blanket Purchase Agreements is available in account numbers 116.160502.51900.592020.001247.000.000, 164.160301.55400.592020.001401.000.000, and 164.160301.55400.592020.001551.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it authorizes the appropriate City officials to execute Blanket Purchase Agreements with each of the highest ranked firms, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That it authorizes the appropriate City officials to negotiate agreements between the selected firms and homeowners embodying the terms and conditions approved by the City Commission this date, in a form acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 4: That if the appropriate City officials are unable to negotiate agreements in accordance with the City's Community Development Policy thresholds for projects in Category 1, 2, and 3 with the highest ranked firms, they are authorized to terminate negotiations with those firms and proceed to negotiate and execute agreements with the next highest ranked firm(s), in order, until agreements are reached.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.



