

RESOLUTION NO. R-CRA- 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY ("CRA"), APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CRA OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH SOUTHEASTERN ENGINEERING CONTRACTORS, INC., FOR THE INSTALLATION OF BACKFLOW PREVENTERS ALONG 30 EAST/WEST STREETS, FROM HOLLYWOOD BOULEVARD TO SHERIDAN STREET, IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$1,016,187.00, WITH AN ADDITIONAL 30% CONTINGENCY OF UP TO \$304,856.10 FOR A TOTAL COST UP TO \$1,321,043.10; IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 38.41(C)(5) OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE. (PIGGYBACK)

WHEREAS, the Community Redevelopment Agency ("CRA") needs to hire an established company with experience in construction and rehabilitation of stormwater infrastructure, to install backflow preventers along 30 City streets from Hollywood Boulevard to Sheridan Street; and

WHEREAS, the CRA Board directed staff to evaluate and implement coastal resiliency, flood management improvements and infrastructure hardening to curb the effects of climate change and sea level rise; and

WHEREAS, the CRA along with the Department of Public Utilities ("Department"), evaluated the conditions of the Central Beach segment and concluded that the installation of redundant backflow preventers will be beneficial to improve localized flooding due to high tides; and

WHEREAS, at the March 4, 2026, CRA Board meeting, the Department and their consultant, CDM Smith and Associates, Inc. ("CDM"), recommended timely installation of redundant backflow preventers due to their effective improvement of localized flooding due to high tides; and

WHEREAS, at the March 4, 2026, CRA Board Meeting, CRA staff presented the estimated cost of labor and materials for the installation of 30 backflow preventers along Central Beach, from Hollywood Boulevard to Sheridan Street, in the amount of \$1,016,187,00, with an additional 30% contingency of \$304,856.10 for restoration work, drainage adjustments, utility conflicts and other field unforeseen conditions among others for a total cost of \$1,321,043.10 to Southeastern Engineering Contractors Inc. ("Southeastern"), attached as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, at the March 4, 2026, CRA Board meeting, the Board considered the recommendation of Department and CDM, to install 30 redundant backflow preventers as a

quick, easily implementable and highly reliable measure to improve localize tidal flooding due to high tides; and

WHEREAS, the CRA Board directed staff to return with a resolution for the material and installation for the 30 backflow preventers at the earliest possible time to initiate implementation; and

WHEREAS, the CRA Board approved the Capital Improvement Plan in September 2025, which included resiliency and infrastructure hardening; and

WHEREAS, the desired Citywide Stormwater Improvements ESSD Project No. 25-11071 were competitively bid by the Department through Invitation for Bid No. IFB-266-25-JJ (“IFB”) on December 11, 2024, and awarded to Southeastern under Contract ID No. C-25-1504 (“Contract”); and

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2025, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2025-158, attached as Exhibit “B,” which approved and authorized the Department to execute the Contract with Southeastern; and

WHEREAS, the current term of the Contract is from August 4, 2025, through August 3, 2027, with an option to renew the contract for two additional one-year terms; and

WHEREAS, staff reviewed the IFB and Contract and determined that line-item descriptions and costs were appropriate, attached as Exhibit “C”; and

WHEREAS, Southeastern has agreed to extend to the CRA the same pricing under the terms and conditions set forth in the Contract; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.41(C)(5) of the Procurement Code allows the Chief Procurement Officer to procure, without formal solicitation procedures, all goods, supplies, materials, equipment, and services that are the subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof (“piggyback”), provided that the goods, supplies, materials, equipment, or services are the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the entities listed above and is based strictly on competitive bids, quotations, or competitive proposals and not on any preference and such utilization of other governmental entities contracts shall be permitted only during the term of the other governmental entity’s contract; and

WHEREAS, the CRA Executive Director and Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the CRA Board approve and authorize the execution of an Agreement to Southeastern for the installation of 30 backflow preventers on 30 east/west streets from Hollywood Boulevard to Sheridan Street in an amount up to \$1,016,187,00, with an additional 30% contingency of up to \$304,856.10 for restoration work, drainage adjustments, utility conflicts and other field unforeseen conditions for a total cost of up to \$1,321,043.10; and

WHEREAS, funding in the amount of \$1,325,000.00 will be made available in

account number 163.639901.55200.563060.001893.000.000 subject to adoption of a companion budget amendment resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY.

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the issuance, by the appropriate CRA officials, of an Agreement with Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc., together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the Executive Director of the CRA and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the CRA's General Counsel.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
