SUBJECT: Proposed Agreement for the 2026 World Cup Watch Parties with
New Hibernians of Hollywood, Inc.

I have reviewed the above referenced Agreement with the participating Department/Office(s), and the proposed general business terms and other significant provisions are as follows:

- 1) Department/Division involved – Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts
 - 2) Type of Agreement – Agreement for the 2026 World Cup Watch Parties on June 27, 2026 and July 19, 2026
 - 3) Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) – Pursuant to Section 38.40(C)(9) of the City’s Code of Ordinances, the City Commission may, when in the best interests of the City, by a 5/7 vote, waive competitive bidding and competitive proposal requirements for the purchase of, and contracts for, supplies, materials, equipment or services.
 - 4) Term of Contract:
 - a) initial – It is expressly understood and agreed that this Agreement is for the duration of this Event only and that NHHI has no right or privilege other than that expressly provided herein.
 - b) renewals (if any) – n/a
 - c) who exercises option to renew – n/a
 - 5) Contract Amount – Up to \$75,000.00 for each Agreement (which includes up to \$35,000.00 for Police and fire expenses).
 - 6) Termination Rights – This Agreement may be terminated in whole or in part by the COH, upon written notice to NHHI when the COH determines in its sole discretion that it is in the COH’s interest to do so.
 - 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements – Contractor shall comply with applicable City requirements.
 - 8) Scope of Services – NHHI will coordinate and contract all vendors, services and sponsor negotiations relating to the production of the Watch Parties.
 - 9) Other Significant Provisions: n/a
