A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH LAYNE CHRISTENSEN COMPANY, IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$405,010.00 FOR MECHANICAL INTEGRITY TESTING OF DEEP INJECTION WELLS NO. 1, NO. 2, NO. 3 AND NO. 4 IN THE SOUTHERN REGIONAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AUTHORIZATION TO PROCEED FOR WORK ORDER NUMBER B&C 26-01 WITH BROWN AND CALDWELL, IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$209,375.00 FOR CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION SERVICES FOR THIS PROJECT; AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Utilities (“Department”) operates the 55.5 million gallon per day (“MGD”) Southern Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant (“SRWWTP”), which uses multiple treatment processes to treat wastewater and produces high-quality effluent that is currently discharged into the four existing Deep Injection Wells No. 1, No. 2, No. 3, and No. 4 or the Atlantic Ocean; and

WHEREAS, the operating permit requires that the five-year mechanical integrity testing program be completed before April 25, 2026, for Deep Injection Well No. 3; before September 6, 2026, for Deep Injection Well No. 4; before August 20, 2027, for Deep Injection Well No. 1; and before August 30, 2027, for Deep Injection Well No. 2; and

WHEREAS, on August 30, 2023, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2023-251, which authorized the execution of continuing consulting engineering services contracts with five firms for the Water Treatment Plant and SRWWTP projects, one of the firms being Brown and Caldwell (“B&C”); and

WHEREAS, on July 2, 2025, pursuant to Resolution No. R-2025-249, the City Commission authorized the appropriate City officials to execute an Authorization to Proceed for Work Order No. B&C 25-03 with B&C for the Design of Mechanical Integrity Testing and Operating Permit Renewal for Deep Injection Wells No. 1, No. 2, No. 3, and No. 4 in an amount up to \$65,122.00; and

WHEREAS, B&C has completed the design of Deep Injection Wells No. 1, No. 2, No. 3, and No. 4 Mechanical Integrity Testing; and

WHEREAS, on December 3, 2025, Invitation for Proposals Number 370-26-JJ was electronically advertised on OpenGov to solicit the desired construction services in accordance with Section 38.43 of the City's Procurement Code; and

WHEREAS, Bid No. IFB-370-26-JJ was opened on Tuesday, December 30, 2025, with the following results:

WHEREAS, B&C, the Department, and the Office of Procurement and Contract Compliance staff thoroughly evaluated the bid proposals in accordance with Section 38.43(F) of the City's Procurement Code, and determined Layne Christensen Company is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, on January 5, 2026, a Notice of Intent to Award was posted on the City's website and on OpenGov, resulting in no bid protests; and

WHEREAS, the Department requested a proposal from B&C to provide construction administration services for the project, and B&C submitted a proposal in an amount up to \$209,375.00; and

WHEREAS, the Department staff evaluated the scope and fee proposal and determined that the negotiated fee is fair, reasonable, and in accordance with industry standards; and

WHEREAS, the Department Director and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the appropriate City officials to execute a contract with Layne Christensen Company in an amount up to \$405,010.00 for construction services related to Mechanical Integrity Testing of deep Injection Wells No. 1, No. 2, No. 3, and No. 4, and to execute the attached Authorization to Proceed for Work Order No. B&C 26-01 with B&C in an amount up to \$209,375.00 for construction administration services for the project; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan was adopted and approved by the City Commission pursuant to Resolution R-2025-336 at the second Public Hearing Budget Meeting on September 26, 2025; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the approved FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan as set forth in the attached Exhibit "1"; and

WHEREAS, funding for construction administration services for the project is available in account number 442.409904.53600.531210.001476.000.000; and

WHEREAS, the project is expected to be completed by September 30, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of the attached contract with Layne Christensen Company, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of the attached Authorization to Proceed for Work Order Number B&C 26-01 with Brown and Caldwell, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 4: That these Amendments to the FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2025, and set forth in detail in the attached Exhibit "1," are adopted and authorized as Amendments and/or Adjustments to the Capital Improvement Plan of the City of Hollywood, Florida, for the Fiscal Year 2026.

Section 5: That it approves and authorizes the City Manager or designee to utilize contingency funds reserved for resolving undefined conditions as set forth in the contract, as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 6: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
