A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ENVIROWASTE SERVICES GROUP, INC. FOR EXCAVATED POINT REPAIR AND MANHOLE REHABILITATION FOR INFLOW AND INFILTRATION SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$2,301,272.50 OVER A TWO-YEAR PERIOD, BASED ON CITY OF BOCA RATON CONTRACTS GROUP A AND GROUP B UNDER BID NUMBER 2022-021, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 38.41(C)(5) OF THE CITY'S PROCUREMENT CODE. (PIGGYBACK)

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") is responsible for planning, regulating, designing, constructing, operating, and maintaining the City's wastewater collection system, which includes 86 sewer lift stations, 68 miles of force main, 240 miles of sewer gravity mains, and 4,399 sewer manholes; and

WHEREAS, on September 6, 2024, the City received Consent Order Number 21-0392 from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, requiring the City to evaluate and improve the performance of its wastewater collection system; and

WHEREAS, to address the Consent Order, the Department desires to obtain excavated point repairs and manhole rehabilitation services to identify sources of inflow and infiltration within the City's sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Boca Raton competitively solicited these services through Bid No. 2022-021 on November 2, 2022, and subsequently awarded the bid to Envirowaste Services Group, Inc. ("Envirowaste") pursuant to contracts Group A—Excavated Point Repairs and Group B—Manhole Rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the Group A and Group B contracts extend for five years, from February 23, 2023, through February 23, 2028, with an automatic renewal for three one-year terms unless terminated earlier as provided by the contracts; and

WHEREAS, Envirowaste has agreed to extend the same pricing, terms, and conditions as those contained in the Group A and Group B contracts to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Department desires to use the competitively awarded Group A and Group B contracts to obtain excavated point repair and manhole rehabilitation services for a two-year period, up to \$2,301,272.50; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.41(C)(5) of the Procurement Code allows the Chief Procurement Officer to procure, without formal solicitation procedures, all goods, supplies, materials, equipment, and services that are the subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof (“piggyback”), provided that the goods, supplies, materials, equipment, or services are the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the entities listed above and is based strictly on competitive bids, quotations, or competitive proposals and not on any preference and such utilization of other governmental entities contracts shall be permitted only during the term of the other governmental entity’s contract; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Utilities and the Director of Procurement and Performance Management recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the execution of an agreement with Envirowaste for a two-year period for an amount up to \$2,301,272.50; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project was included in the amended FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan, and is available in account number 442.409901.53600.563010.000712.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of an agreement with Envirowaste Services Group, Inc., together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
