A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH RF ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,599,120.00 FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES RELATED TO THE TRANSITION TO A SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE SYSTEM AT THE SOUTHERN REGIONAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT; AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Southern Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant ("SRWWTP") currently uses a chlorine gas disinfection system as the final step in wastewater treatment prior to disposal; and

WHEREAS, the existing chlorine gas system, installed in the 1990s, has experienced operational and safety issues, including leaks; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") determined it is necessary to construct a temporary sodium hypochlorite system to replace the existing disinfection process; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2024, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. R-2024-198, authorizing the appropriate City officials to execute an Authorization to Proceed for Work Order Number H&S 24-07 with Hazen and Sawyer, P.C. ("H&S") for professional engineering services for the design, permitting, and bidding of a temporary hypochlorite disinfection system at the SRWWTP, in an amount not to exceed \$334,918.00; and

WHEREAS, H&S has completed the design of the temporary hypochlorite disinfection system that will allow for the transition to the permanent system; and

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2026, Invitation for Bid No. IFB-373-26-JJ was electronically advertised on OpenGov in accordance with Section 38.43(A) of the City's Procurement Code; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2026, three bids were received electronically and opened with the following results:

WHEREAS, H&S, the Department Director and the Director of Procurement and Performance Management determined RF Environmental Services, Inc. to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder with a total bid of \$4,599,120.00; and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2026, a Notice of Intent to Award was posted on the City's website and on OpenGov, which resulted in no bid protests; and

WHEREAS, the Department Director and the Director of Procurement and Performance Management recommend awarding RF Environmental Services, Inc. with a contract consisting of both base bid items and negotiated alternate bid items, as determined to be in the City's best interest; and

WHEREAS, the Department Director and the Director of Procurement and Performance Management recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the appropriate City officials to execute the attached contract with RF Environmental Services, Inc. in the amount up to \$4,599,120.00 for Construction Services related to a temporary hypochlorite disinfection system; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan was adopted and approved by the City Commission pursuant to Resolution R-2025-336 at the second Public Budget Hearing on September 25, 2025; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the approved FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan as set forth in the attached Exhibit "1," Budget and Capital Amendments: Water and Sewer Fund (442); and

WHEREAS, the estimated time to complete the new hypochlorite disinfection system will be 360 days from the Notice to Proceed date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of the attached contract with RF Environmental Services, Inc., together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That these Amendments to the FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2025, and set forth in detail in the attached Exhibit "1," are adopted and authorized as Amendments to the FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan of the City of Hollywood, Florida.

Section 4: That the Department of Financial Services is authorized to establish such line-item accounts as may be necessary to properly monitor and track said appropriations.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
