A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH T2 SYSTEMS, INC. FOR T2 UPSAFETY PERMITS AND ENFORCEMENT SOFTWARE SOLUTION FOR PARKING AND POLICE BEACH ENFORCEMENT SERVICES, IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$296,134.00, OVER A THREE-YEAR PERIOD, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 38.41 (C)(11)(A) OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE. (SOFTWARE AND HARDWARE EXCEPTION)

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2025, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2025-183, approving a Blanket Purchase Agreement with T2 Systems, Inc. for webhosting, extended warranty, and maintenance services for new and existing multi-space pay stations in an estimated amount of \$736,200.00 for the period from July 3, 2025, through July 2, 2029; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Parking and Code Compliance desires to add the T2 UPSafety Permits and Enforcement Software Solution for parking enforcement and police beach enforcement operations; and

WHEREAS, the T2 UPSafety solution is an enterprise software platform that interfaces with the City's existing parking meter system and provides additional service features including permit management, citation management, appeals and adjudication processing, patron portal functionality, back-office administration tools, and integrated enforcement software services for the City's parking and police beach enforcement operations; and

WHEREAS, the proposed purchase includes software subscriptions/hardware, training, maintenance, handheld printers, and associated supplies for an amount up to \$223,134.00 and a contingency for unexpected repairs and replacements for an amount up to \$73,000.00 necessary to support the City's parking enforcement and police beach enforcement operations, for a total amount up to \$296,134.00 over a three-year period; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.41(C)(11)(a) of the City Code provides that software and hardware subscriptions, licensing, and maintenance with the company from which the software and hardware were purchased, as set forth in § 38.43 or § 38.44, or its authorized representative, are exempt from the competitive bidding and competitive proposal requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Office of Parking and Code Compliance and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the execution of an agreement with T2 Systems, Inc., for the T2 UPSafety Permits and

Enforcement Software Solution, in an amount up to \$296,134.00, over a three-year period; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the funding for this agreement is available in the FY 2026 Operating Budget and FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan in account numbers 446.159901.54500.564420.001493.000.000, 446.150102.54500.552140.000000.000.000, 446.150101.54500.552280.000000.000.000, and 001.204001.52100.564420.000000.000.000 and will be budgeted in subsequent fiscal years' operating budgets subject to approval and adoption by the City Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of an agreement with T2 Systems, Inc. for the T2 UPSafety Permits and Enforcement Software Solution, together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
