A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH OVERDOSE DATA TO ACTION (OD2A) PROGRAM GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ACCEPT SAID GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$344,988.00 WITH NO REQUIRED MATCHING FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ALL APPLICABLE GRANT DOCUMENTS; AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 OPERATING BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the City of Hollywood Fire Rescue & Beach Safety Department (“Department”) has the capacity to administer public health and safety initiatives to reduce overdoses and improve community outcomes; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Health has made available Overdose Data to Action (“OD2A”) grant funding to support evidence-based strategies for overdose prevention, surveillance, and response; and

WHERE, the Department submitted an application for the Florida Department of Health for the OD2A grant; and

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded \$344,988.00 from the OD2A grant with no matching funds required from the City; and

WHEREAS, the Department will use the awarded OD2A funding to support program components, including, but not limited to, personnel, medical supplies, outreach materials, and community-based prevention efforts; and

WHEREAS, the grant supports the City’s ongoing commitment to public safety, community health, and regional collaboration in addressing the opioid epidemic; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to enter into a grant agreement with the Florida Department of Health to accept and administer OD2A funding for the period May 1, 2026, through August 31, 2028; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief recommends that the City ratify the submission of the City’s application for the OD2A grant and authorize the appropriate City officials to accept the grant award and execute all applicable grant documents; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2026 Operating Budget of the City of Hollywood was adopted and approved by the City Commission pursuant to Resolution R-2025-335 at the 2nd Public Budget Hearing on September 25, 2025; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution seeks to amend the budget as detailed in the attached Exhibit "1."

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 2: That the City ratifies the submission of an application for the OD2A grant.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to accept the grant, if awarded, provided that the City Manager shall have the discretion to refuse the grant in those circumstances where she determines it is in the best interest of the City to do so, in which case she shall advise the City Commission of her intention to refuse the grant.

Section 4: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of a grant agreement with the Florida Department of Health for the OD2A program, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 5: That it authorizes the appropriate City officials to execute all applicable grant documents and agreements in a form acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 6: That the amendments to the Operating Budget of the City of Hollywood for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2025, relating to the Special Programs Fund (Fund111) and set forth in detail in the attached Exhibit "1" are adopted and authorized as Amendments to the Operating Budget of the City of Hollywood for the Fiscal Year 2026.

Section 7: That the Department of Financial Services is authorized to create and establish in the appropriate fund the necessary accounts to recognize the receipt of grant funding and to appropriate grant-related funding as may be required.

Section 8: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
