A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AUTHORIZATION TO PROCEED WITH CES CONSULTANTS, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING AND INSPECTION SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE JOHNSON STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT AND PUBLIC UTILITY RELOCATION PROJECT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$737,388.74, WHICH INCLUDES OPTION MATERIALS TESTING SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$57,110.00.

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2021, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2021-208, which ranked the highest-qualified firms across ten engineering disciplines and authorized the appropriate City officials to execute continuing services agreements with those firms, including in the discipline of Construction Engineering and Inspection ("CEI"), for which CES Consultants, Inc. ("CES") was among the ranked and qualified firms; and

WHEREAS, to proceed with the construction phase of the Johnson Street Bridge Replacement and Public Utility Relocation Project, the City requires the use of CEI services to ensure compliance with approved plans, specifications, permits, and regulatory requirements; and

WHEREAS, CES previously completed a constructability review of the 90% design for the bridge replacement and public utility relocation under a separate authorization to proceed, issued in October 2025. CES is familiar with the project scope and pre-qualified by FDOT to perform CEI services for the bridge replacement project; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Development Services, Engineering, Transportation and Mobility Division and Public Utilities staff negotiated a proposal with CES to provide CEI and monthly bridge inspection services to support construction administration and management of the Johnson Street Bridge Replacement and Utility Relocation Project in an amount not to exceed \$680,278.74 and optional materials testing in an amount not to exceed \$57,110.00; and

WHEREAS, staff evaluated the proposal, inclusive of the scope and fee, and determined that the negotiated fee is fair and reasonable and in accordance with industry standards; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Development Services and the Director of Public Utilities recommend that the City Commission authorize the City Manager to execute the Authorization to Proceed, attached as Exhibit "A" with CES based on its proposal and the terms and conditions of the Professional Engineering Continuing Services Agreement for Construction Engineering and Inspection Services; and

WHEREAS, the not to exceed amount is \$737,388.74 with an approximate breakdown of:

- Public Utilities - Sewer: \$27,691.10
- Public Utilities - Water: \$41,536.66
- Engineering: \$668,160.98 ; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project was included in the amended FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan and is available in account number 334.149901.54100.563010.001687.000.000, 442.409904.53600.563013.001913.000.000, and 442.409903.53600.563013.001914.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the City Manager, of the Authorization to Proceed with CES Consultants Inc., attached as Exhibit "A", together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

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Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
