A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE CITY OF LAUDERHILL SHOULD THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD BE AWARDED AS A SUBRECIPIENT OF THE 2026 WORLD CUP EVENT FUNDING IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$65,000.00; AUTHORIZING THE REQUIRED ONE TO ONE MATCHING FUNDS TO BE PAID FROM PARKS, RECREATION AND CULTURAL ARTS 2026 OPERATIONAL BUDGET; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ALL OTHER APPLICABLE DOCUMENTS AND AGREEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Lauderhill ("Lauderhill") has entered into a Sponsorship Agreement with Broward County ("County") to receive funding for events related to the 2026 World Cup ("County Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the County Agreement authorizes Lauderhill to approve subawards to municipalities ("Participating Cities") within Broward County for eligible events ("Subrecipient Events"); and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts ("PRCA") has identified the need to fund two 2026 World Cup events in the Hollywood Downtown; and

WHEREAS, all funding under all subrecipient memorandums of understanding ("MOU") are issued by Lauderhill pursuant to the County Agreement and in an amount up to \$65,000.00 in the aggregate across all Participating Cities combined; and

WHEREAS, the maximum reimbursement available to the Participating Cities under this MOU shall not exceed an amount equal to \$65,000.00 divided by the total number of municipalities that have executed a subrecipient MOU with Lauderhill pursuant to the County Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the MOU requires a one-to-one match from the subrecipient; and

WHEREAS, the Director of PRCA recommends that the City Commission approve and authorize the appropriate City officials to execute an MOU with Lauderhill for subrecipient participation in the 2026 World Cup Events, authorize the required matching funds, and authorize the appropriate City officials to execute all other applicable documents and agreements; and

WHEREAS, PRCA will provide the in-kind match utilizing account number 001.300601.57200.549110.000000.000.000; and

WHEREAS, the Sponsorship Agreement with Broward County will require a future budget amendment to recognize the subrecipient award once notification of an award is received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute a memorandum of understanding with the City of Lauderhill, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney, provided that the City Manager shall have the discretion to refuse the funding in those circumstances where she determines it is in the best interest of the City to do so, in which case she shall advise the City Commission of her intention to refuse the funding.

Section 3: That it authorizes the required one-to-one matching funds pursuant to the memorandum of understanding.

Section 4: That it authorizes the appropriate City officials to execute all applicable documents and agreements in a form acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 5: That the Department of Financial Services is authorized to establish such line-item accounts as may be necessary to properly monitor and track said appropriations.

Section 6: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
