A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AUTHORIZATION TO PROCEED WITH THE CORRADINO GROUP, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT PROFESSIONAL CONSULTING SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE JOHNSON STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT AND PUBLIC UTILITY RELOCATION PROJECT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$499,240.00.

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2021, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2021-208, which approved and authorized appropriate City officials to execute continuing services agreements with the highest-ranked firms based upon 10 disciplines to provide engineering services for Citywide projects, one of the firms being Corradino Group, Inc. ("Corradino"); and

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2023, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2023-324, authorizing the Corradino to complete the final design, permitting, and construction specifications for the replacement and widening of the existing Johnson Street bridge located between North 30th Road and North 31st Avenue; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2024, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2024-320, authorizing Corradino to incorporate the relocation of City-owned utilities in the final engineering design for the bridge replacement and widening project; and

WHEREAS, Corradino has completed the design, construction specifications and permit submittals for the Johnson Street Bridge Replacement and Public Utility Relocation Project; and

WHEREAS, the next phase of the project is construction, and Corradino's designer is the Engineer of Record; and

WHEREAS, the construction phase of the project requires additional consultant services from Corradino to provide construction administration, construction management support, technical coordination, and Engineer of Record responsibilities and certifications for both the bridge replacement and utility relocation efforts; and

WHEREAS, staff from the Departments of Development Services and Public Utilities negotiated a proposal with Corradino to provide the referenced professional consulting services, including community outreach assistance, in an amount not to exceed \$499,240.00; and

WHEREAS, staff evaluated the proposal, including the scope and fee, and determined that the negotiated fee is fair and reasonable and in accordance with industry standards; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Development Services and Director of Public Utilities recommend that the City Commission authorize the City Manager to execute the Authorization to Proceed, attached as Exhibit "A," with Corradino, based on its proposal and the terms and conditions of the Professional Engineering Continuing Services Agreement for Civil Engineering and Roadway Design Services; and

WHEREAS, the not to exceed amount is \$499,240.00 with an approximate breakdown of:

- Public Utilities - Sewer: \$43,342.00
- Public Utilities - Water: \$65,013.00
- Engineering: \$390,885.00 ; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project was included in the amended FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan, and is available in account numbers 334.149901.54100.563010.001687.000.000, 442.409904.53600.563013.001913.000.000, and 442.409903.53600.563013.001914.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the City Manager, of the attached Authorization to Proceed, attached as Exhibit "A," with Corradino Group, Inc., together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
