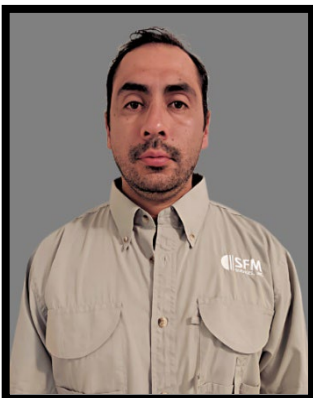

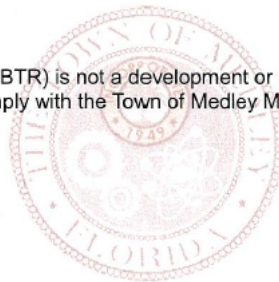

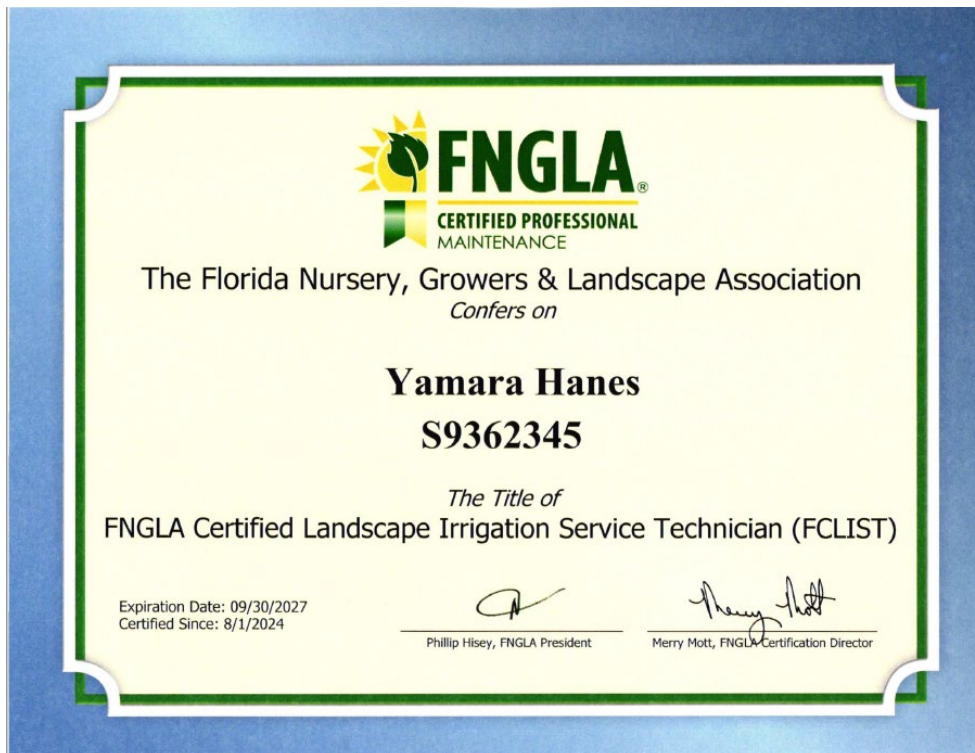

## E. APPROACH TO SCOPE OF WORK

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SFM’s approach to delivering the City of Hollywood’s Tree Planting Program is structured, safety-driven, and fully compliant with all applicable City, State, and Federal requirements. Our methodology emphasizes proactive coordination, disciplined planning, certified arborist oversight, and consistent communication—ensuring tree planting activities are completed efficiently, safely, and in alignment with grant requirements, sustainability goals, and “Right Tree, Right Place” principles from program inception through closeout.

### **Transition Objectives**

- Ensure a seamless, on-time program startup aligned with grant milestones
- Establish clear roles, communication protocols, and escalation procedures
- Confirm full operational readiness prior to initiating planting activities
- Maintain accountability through documented installations, inspections, and follow-up
- Build a collaborative working relationship with the City of Hollywood’s designated representatives

### **Transition Process**

SFM will implement a structured transition process that includes mobilizing a dedicated program team; conducting a kickoff meeting with City staff to confirm program objectives, planting priorities, data requirements, and reporting protocols; coordinating site reviews and preliminary planting locations; staging equipment and materials; and finalizing schedules aligned with the City’s timeline. Post-startup reviews will be conducted to confirm performance, address adjustments, and maintain alignment with grant and program requirements.

### **Service Execution & Performance Commitments**

SFM will coordinate closely with the City of Hollywood to plan and execute tree planting activities across City-owned properties and public rights-of-way. All work will be supervised by an ISA Certified Arborist and performed in accordance with accepted horticultural best practices, ANSI standards, applicable City ordinances, and utility clearance requirements. Tree installation will include proper excavation, soil preparation, planting depth, staking or guying as required, mulching, watering, and site restoration. SFM will maintain ongoing communication with the City’s designated representative and conduct routine inspections and performance reviews to ensure quality, consistency, and long-term tree health.

### **Mobilization & Work Process**

Upon authorization to proceed, SFM will verify site conditions, identify underground utilities, coordinate required permits or right-of-way approvals, and assign ISA Certified Arborist oversight. Pre-task safety briefings and job hazard analyses will be conducted prior to installation activities. Work will be completed in accordance with the approved planting plan, followed by documentation of installed trees, site cleanup, and notification to the City for inspection and acceptance.

## **Program Support, Warranty & Readiness**

SFM will provide structured grow-in maintenance and a one-year warranty for all planted trees. Routine inspections will be conducted to monitor health and establishment, with proactive corrective actions or replacements performed as required. SFM is prepared to adjust schedules or deployment as needed to accommodate weather conditions, community engagement events, or City-directed priorities, ensuring continuous progress toward program completion and grant compliance.

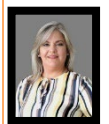

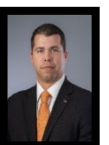

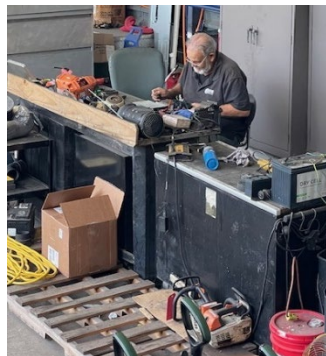
## FLEET PROGRAM

SFM has a comprehensive maintenance program in place to ensure that its fleet and equipment are well-maintained and functioning optimally. To achieve this, we have our Fleet Supervisor Michelle Moya along with a team of three full-time mechanics who are dedicated to overseeing the maintenance and upkeep of the fleet and equipment. Their primary responsibility is to ensure that all equipment is in top condition, minimizing downtime and maximizing operational effectiveness.

Additionally, SFM utilizes Whip Around, a web-based fleet maintenance software that allows us to track, document, and report vital data we need to optimize the performance of our fleet and heavy equipment. Every driver completes a pre-trip inspection daily as a preventative maintenance measure. Whip Around also tracks fuel usage and integrates with our vehicle tracking software, GEOTAB.



SFM has a max life equipment policy under which equipment is replaced once it has expired its life expectancy. This ensures that SFM's operations are not hindered by outdated or malfunctioning equipment. By implementing this policy, SFM is able to maximize the lifespan and performance of its equipment, leading to increased efficiency and productivity.

## QUALITY CONTROL

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SFM utilizes OrangeQC, a web-based quality control platform, to monitor performance, document compliance, and ensure accountability across all service locations.

## INSPECTIONS & REPORTING

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Routine inspections are conducted and documented using time-stamped photos, GPS verification, and standardized scoring. Inspection results are accessible to City representatives through a secure web portal, providing visibility into service quality, inspection frequency, and response times.

## PERFORMANCE MONITORING

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OrangeQC analytics allow SFM to track trends, identify issues early, and implement corrective actions promptly. Performance data is reviewed regularly by management to ensure consistent service delivery and adherence to contract standards.

## WORK ORDER & COMMUNICATION MANAGEMENT

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OrangeQC also serves as a centralized communication and work order platform. Service requests submitted via email, web portal, or mobile device are automatically logged, assigned, and tracked through resolution. The system records response times and completion status, ensuring transparency and timely follow-up.

This structured quality control framework ensures reliable performance, clear communication, and continuous improvement throughout the term of the contract.

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Paulino Hernandez serves as SFM Landscape Services' designated Quality Control Officer, bringing more than 40 years of experience in landscape maintenance and operations. 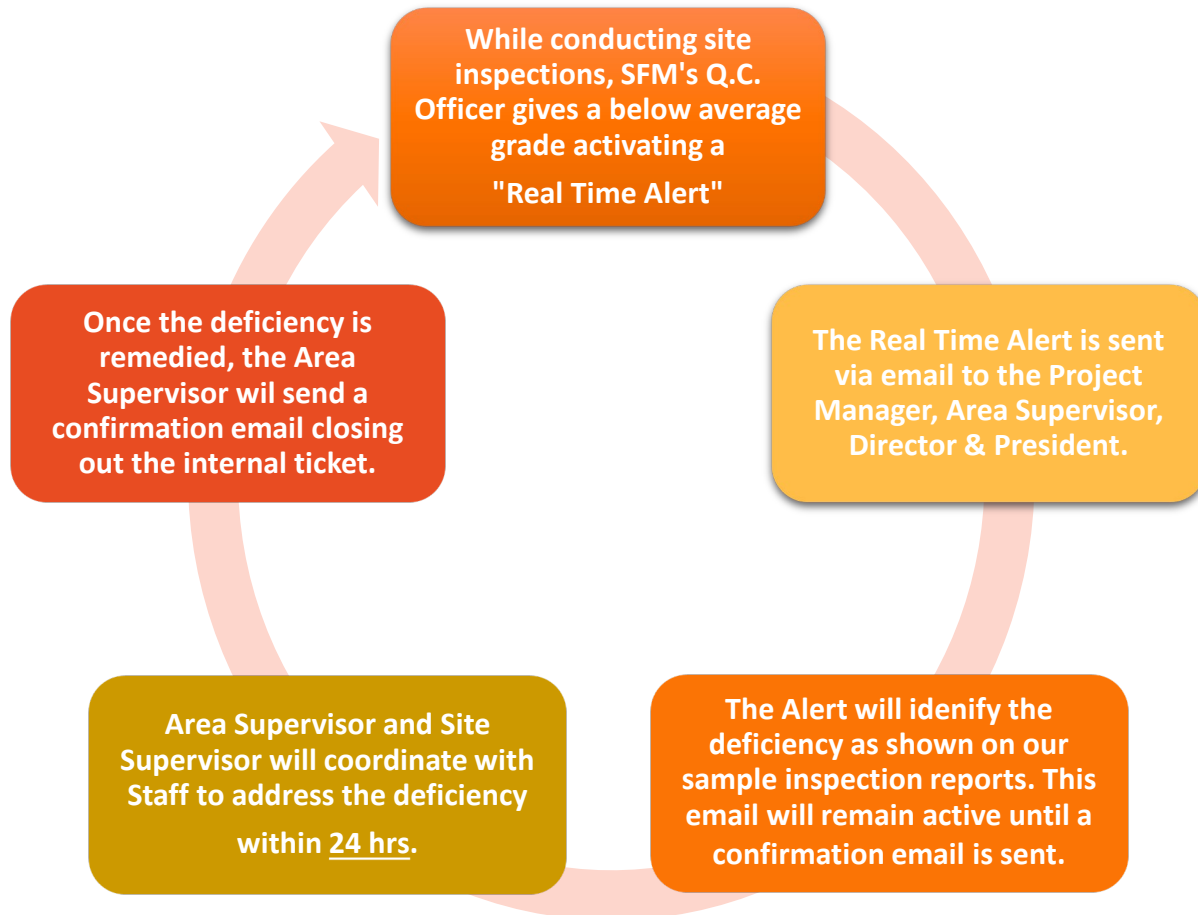

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## SFM'S INTERNAL COMMUNICATION SYSTEM

In order to maintain high quality standards, SFM relies on effective internal communication to quickly remedy any account deficiency. Below is a representation of SFM's internal communication process when an area is found deficient by a quality control officer.



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## CLIENT TICKET SYSTEM

Through our Quality Control software, we ask our clients to use the "Ticket System". This feature helps us document and keep track of the quality of our services.

***Here's how it works:***

All you have to do is send an email to our Quality Control System at [ticket@sfmtservices.com](mailto:ticket@sfmtservices.com) so we can address it. It's that simple! This email will trigger a ticket alert from the client to the SFM administration, which consists of the Contract Manager, Supervisors, SFM's COO, and SFM's President.

This ticket will remain open sending continuous alerts until addressed by the Supervisor and our SFM Operations Manager, who will then respond. Their response will then trigger a "pending" designation. Once the ticket's content is addressed, it will be shown as completed and filed within your folder in our QC program. This will enable us to sporadically open the folder and see if there are any re-occurring trends that will allow us to proactively service your property.

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## POLICIES & PROCEDURES

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## HIRING, SCREENING, AND TRAINING

SFM maintains established hiring, screening, and training procedures to ensure all personnel assigned to City contracts meet industry standards and regulatory requirements. All employees undergo Level 1 and Level 2 investigative background checks, including nationwide screenings, prior to assignment. Employees requiring access to regulated or sensitive areas are subject to additional screening as applicable.

SFM does not employ individuals who fail to meet background eligibility requirements, including those with recent violent felonies, controlled substance trafficking convictions, sexual offender status, or inability to verify legal work authorization. All hiring practices comply with FCRA, E-Verify, and applicable federal and state laws. Employee files include required health screenings, safety training, and OSHA-compliant documentation.

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## STAFFING METHODOLOGY

SFM follows a structured hiring and onboarding process that includes local recruitment, supervisory interviews, application and employment verification, background checks and drug screening, and completion of I-9 requirements. All employees receive site-specific and safety training prior to deployment. Select positions may be staffed on a part-time basis to maintain a trained on-call labor pool, ensuring continuity of coverage and rapid response capability.

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## EMPLOYEE MONITORING & IDENTIFICATION

Supervisors and crew leaders operating SFM vehicles are monitored through GPS-based tracking systems, allowing real-time verification of site activity, service duration, and routing. The system supports daily activity reporting, incident documentation, geofencing, and safe driving monitoring.

All drivers are enrolled in SambaSafety, providing continuous motor vehicle record monitoring.

SFM personnel are issued uniforms and photo identification badges, which must be worn at all times while on City property. Uniforms are professional, easily identifiable, and may be customized to meet City preferences upon request.

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## DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE PROGRAM

SFM maintains a Drug-Free Workplace Program to promote a safe and productive work environment. Employees are prohibited from the use, possession, or influence of drugs or alcohol while on duty or conducting company business. The program includes pre-employment screening, random, post-accident, and reasonable-suspicion testing, supported by ongoing safety training. This policy reinforces regulatory compliance, reduces risk, and supports professional conduct across all operations.

## SAFETY & TRAINING PROGRAM

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At SFM, safety is not just a policy—it is a core value that defines how we operate every day. We are committed to maintaining a safe and compliant working environment for our employees, clients, and the communities we serve. Because the scope of work for tree trimming and removal involves potentially hazardous conditions, SFM enforces a comprehensive **Landscape Safety and Training Program** designed to exceed OSHA, ANSI Z133, and FDOT Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) standards.



### **Program Objectives**

SFM's Safety and Training Program aims to:

1. Prevent accidents and injuries through proactive planning, hazard recognition, and safe work practices.
2. Educate all personnel on regulatory compliance, site-specific hazards, and individual safety responsibilities.
3. Promote consistent communication between management and field staff to identify and resolve safety concerns.
4. Reinforce a safety-first culture by recognizing exemplary performance and sharing best practices.
5. Continuously evaluate and improve our procedures through audits, inspections, and feedback.

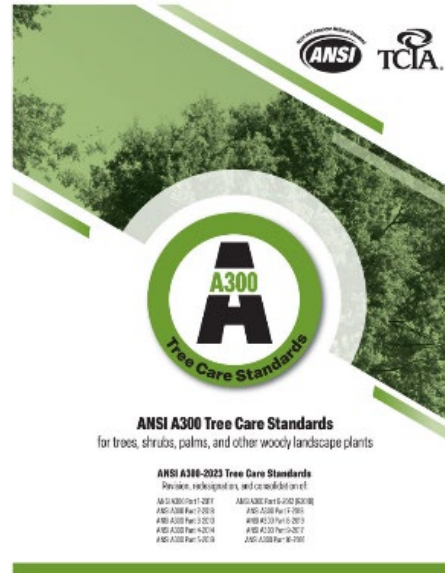
### **Key Components**

- **Comprehensive Safety Training:** All employees receive training in OSHA and ANSI Z133 standards, proper equipment operation, traffic control, emergency procedures, and safe climbing and rigging techniques.

- **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):** Crews are equipped with and required to wear appropriate PPE, including helmets, eye and ear protection, gloves, chainsaw chaps, and high-visibility apparel.
- **Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) Compliance:** Certified personnel develop and implement MOT plans per FDOT standards to ensure pedestrian and vehicular safety in all work zones.
- **Safety Communication & Accountability:** Daily toolbox talks and weekly safety meetings reinforce expectations, review incidents or near misses, and promote continuous learning.
- **Incident Reporting & Corrective Action:** All incidents, hazards, and near misses are documented and investigated promptly to prevent recurrence.

## In-House Arbor Care Training

As part of our commitment to specialized training, SFM offers a **robust Arbor Care training program**. Our Arbor Care crews are trained in compliance with:

- **ANSI A300 Tree Care Standards**
- **ANSI Z133 Arboricultural Safety Standards**



Training is led by **Luis Sanchez**, SFM's In-House Risk and Safety Manager and a certified safety instructor with the State of Florida. This internal expertise allows SFM to:

- Train and retrain employees as needed throughout the year.
- Maintain strict adherence to industry standards.
- React quickly to changing safety requirements or site-specific challenges.

This in-house capability is a competitive advantage that ensures our crews are consistently prepared to perform work safely and professionally.
